

ELECTROCARDIOGRAM (ECG) CLEARANCE

Parent/Guardian Instructions:

An electrocardiogram (ECG) helps identify those who are at risk for sudden cardiac arrest or death. An ECG may assist in diagnosing several different heart conditions that contribute to sudden cardiac arrest. In accordance with School Board Policy 406.1, Flagler Schools requires each high school student wishing to participate in athletics, JROTC, marching band, or color guard to have one (1) ECG screening on file prior to participation. The ECG must be completed by a licensed physician, licensed physician assistant (PA), or certified advanced registered nurse practitioner (ARNP). All students will have to be cleared prior to participation.
