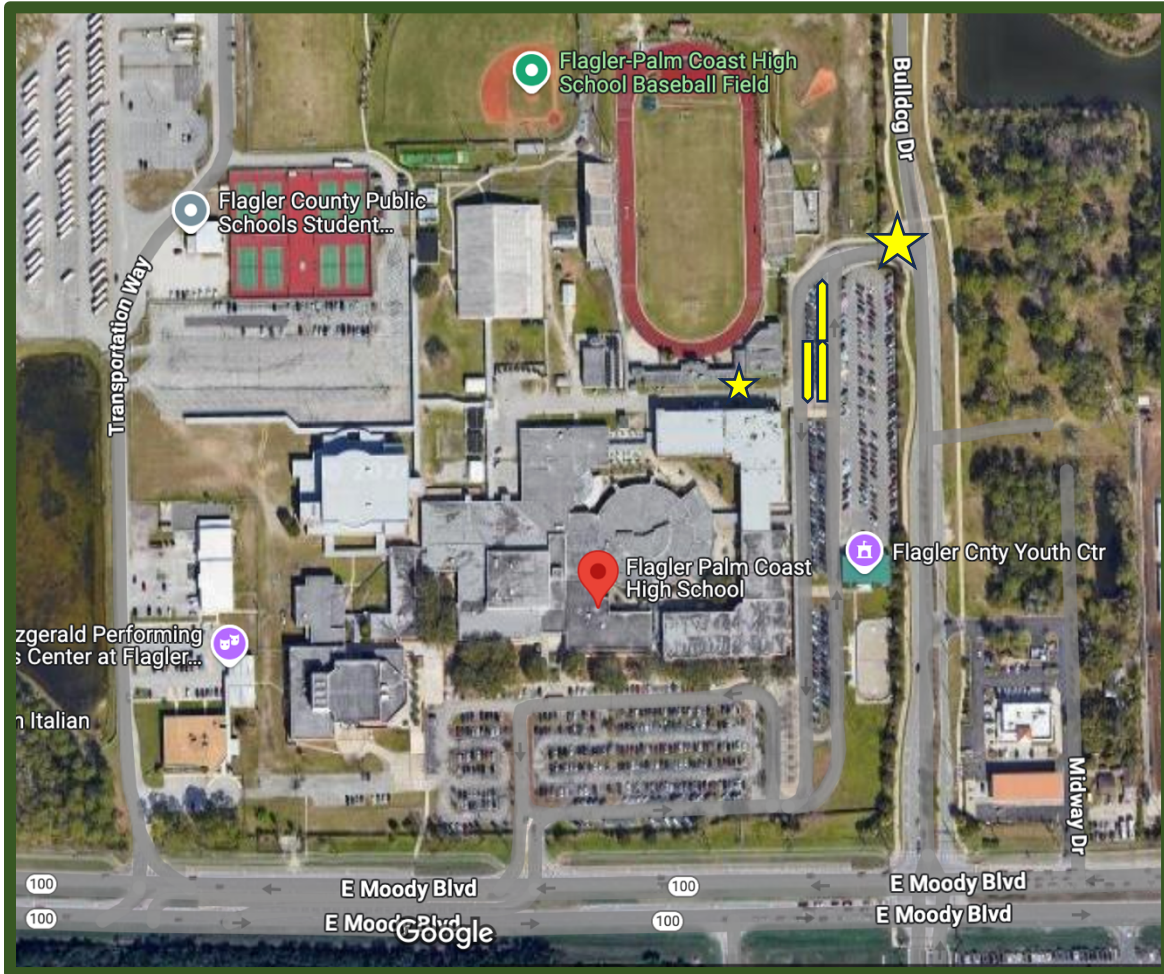

VISITING TEAM INFORMATION

Team Bus Parking:

Team buses and athletic training vans should enter the stadium through the **east Bulldog Drive gate**. Flagler Palm Coast Air Force ROTC cadets' man this gate and will allow entry to only team buses, game officials, and visiting team vans (maximum of 4 coach/admin vehicles). We can accommodate up to three team buses in this lot. This gate remains closed before and during the game for guests and spectators. Once teams have disembarked the bus, ROTC cadets will line up all buses facing north. After the game, your teams can exit the stadium through the locker room back door and board the buses in the adjacent lot (to the left). Teams will then exit campus through the same Bulldog Drive gate. See below map for entry gate (star) and bus parking (arrows).



Locker Room:

Teams will have access to the visiting locker room in the fieldhouse. If you will choose to not use the space during the game please let the host athletic administrator know. Teams will enter the locker room through the back door of the fieldhouse. The facility will be locked during the game, so valuables can be stored safely. After the game teams will exit the field into the visiting locker room, then exit the fieldhouse through the back door onto the service road. We will have your buses backed up to that door for easy access to boarding. See above map for the entry door to the fieldhouse (star).

Press Box:

Teams will have access to the press box on the top of the west stands. Team will utilize the room closest to the north of the box (if facing the box from the field, all the way to the right opposite the scoreboard). Power hookups and hardwire internet access is available for technology needs. Please limit the number of coaches to three plus one video coordinator to the press box.

Sideline Electricity:

Power hookups for sideline equipment is only available by running extension cords to the visiting ticket booth. Teams will need to provide their own extension cords in order to utilize the power hookups. There are two plugs available on the booth. Teams should bring at least 150' of cord in order to ensure they have enough room to access their sideline equipment.

Visitors Sideline Security:

FPC will station at least one Flagler County Sheriff deputy and two FPCHS administrators on the away side of the stadium at all times. For games with expected larger crowds, the FPC administration will revise our security detail to add additional security support. Visiting teams are expected to help patrol their own sidelines during games. Only visiting team administrators are approved to be on the team sidelines outside of the coaching box. Any other guests including team photographers, videographers, school staff, or coach families should request prior approval from the FPC Athletic Office by Wednesday of game week. Media passes will be issued for approved photographers at the ticket booth. Only those approved prior to gameday will be issued a sideline media credential.

Water / Ice:

FPC Sports Medicine will provide coolers with water and injury ice on your sideline. If you need water or ice refilled at halftime, please make contact with the Head Athletic Trainer (Ron Steinwehr), or by visiting the athletic training room in the fieldhouse, located next to the visiting locker room.

Sports Medicine:

FPC has one full time athletic trainer that will be on duty for all games. Dr. Michael Campbell (Team Doctor) will also be at all home varsity football games. Palm Coast Fire & Rescue will have a mobile EMT unit on site stationed underneath the scoreboard on the south end of the stadium. If you have sports medicine needs to have an immediate medical emergency, please make immediate contact with the athletic trainer or athletic administrator on duty.

If you are in need of the athletic training room we ask you contact the Flagler Palm Coast ATC ahead of time to arrange time for your teams needs.

Inclement Weather:

Flagler Palm Coast follows the FHSAA Lightning Policy and utilizes DTN WeatherSentry for monitoring. If lightning is detected by the home athletic trainer and/or athletic administrator within 10 miles, teams will be cleared from the field and moved to the locker room. We will be on a 30 minute delay from the last lightning strike within the 10 mile radius of the stadium. The home administration will work with the visiting team coaches to notify of updates while we are on the weather delay. Once the weather suspension is lifted, teams will work with the officiating crew to assign an agreed upon and appropriate warm-up period before the game resumes.

In the case we need to clear the stadium, teams will go to their respected locker rooms. Cheerleading teams will go to the cafeteria, located directly across from the home entry gate. Spectators will go to their cars, or the 800 gym located on the west side of campus.

Tickets:

Spectator tickets can be purchased ahead of time by visiting **[Tickets.FPCSports.com](https://tickets.fpcsports.com)**. Ticket gates will open 60 minutes prior to kickoff.

- **General Admission: \$11.00**
 - Credit Cards & touchless pay is accepted at the gate. Convenience and credit card fees apply.
 - Cash is also accepted at the gate.

Comp Tickets for Admission

You have received 10 complementary tickets for coach's wives or families to use for admission. We will not have any additional pass gate lists.

Visiting team administrators will be granted admission with school identification at the gate. At this time, our school district unfortunately does not have reciprocal complementary game admission agreements in place for any schools or school districts outside of Flagler County Schools.

Stadium Spectator Policies:

Flagler County Schools strictly enforces the following restrictions for guests and spectators at all home events:

- No Re-Entry for any reason.
- No Outside Food or Drink (including outside cups & metal tumblers)
- No bags larger than a small clutch. Clear bags are permitted and will be searched.
- No pets (Services dogs must have proper identification and vests)
- No alcohol or tobacco including E-Cigarettes and vapes.

All spectators are expected to practice good sportsmanship and civility while attending athletic events on campus. Abusive language directed towards players, officials, gameday workers & staff, or other guests will not be tolerated and will result with ejection from the facility without refund and the individual will be required to immediately leave the property.

Spectator Parking:

Guest lots will open two hours prior to kickoff. Parking is free of charge.



Game Live Stream / Local Radio:

Flagler County WNZF 1550AM is the official radio provider for FPC Athletics. The radio station may reach out to your athletic department prior to game week requesting information for the broadcast.

Visiting School Radio / Live Stream:

Schools wishing to host local radio broadcasts or live streams should make contact with the FPC athletic office by Wednesday of game week to make arrangements for press box seating assignments and technology needs. All post season FHSAA State Series events must be approved by the FHSAA Communications office, and will require proof of approval before the day of the game.

OFFICIALS INFORMATION

Officials Parking:

All visiting officials should enter the stadium through the **east Bulldog Drive gate**. Flagler Palm Coast Air Force ROTC cadets' man this gate and will allow entry to only those referees in their vehicles. You will park in the assigned coned off spaces directly next to the visitors ticket booth.

Locker Room:

Officials will have access to a private locker room located next to our weight room and athletic training room. Shower and bathroom facilities are available.

Water, Gatorade, and snacks will be stocked in the locker room for our officials.
