Hall of Fame Criteria

Exeter Union High School Hall of Fame recognition is earned by athletes who are considered the top athletic performers to have ever participated in Monarch Athletics.

Hall of Fame athletes are nominated by their coach, and voted on by the Hall of Fame Committee. The Hall of Fame committee is made up of all current Exeter Union head coaches (one vote each), and the athletic director. The Hall of Fame Committee has the final say on all selections. Athletes are inducted if they earn a simple majority of the votes.

Inductees will have their name added to the EUHS Hall of Fame boards in the Smith Gym.

Basic Criteria:

- Athletes must be a graduating senior from a varsity team, who have been a Varsity Letterman for a minimum of 2 years. .

Character:

- Athletes must conduct themselves with integrity on and off the field. A student-athletes discipline record may be a contributing factor. The vote for a Hall of Fame athlete will be based on 50% athletic accomplishments and 50% citizenship and attitude.

Academic Achievement:

- Athletes must have at least a 3.0 weighted overall GPA.

Athletic Success:

- Athletes should be 1st-Team All League, or equivalent, during their high school career.
- Athletes should have attained the highest athletic accolades.
- Breaking school, section, or state records and / or planning on competing at the collegiate level will be added considering factors.
