Due to a renewed focus on ensuring professional, appropriate, and safe interactions with our student-athletes, coaches, administrators, school faculty, and fans, the JSerra Athletic Administration has implemented new media access policies at athletic contests on our campus.

JSerra Athletics Media Access Policy for Football Games

- Please complete all media access requests by THURSDAY at noon of game week.
- **To access our online media access request form, please [CLICK HERE](#).**
- Any media access requests received after the Thursday deadline are NOT guaranteed to be approved.
- All media access requests will be reviewed upon being received. Submission of a media access request does not guarantee approval for field, sideline, or press box access.
- All media access requests will be approved or denied by the Sports Information Director (via phone call or email) by Friday at 2 p.m. on game days.
- Upon entry to the stadium, you must check-in and present a valid CIF-SS media credential to obtain a media access pass for the sideline, field, and press box. Failure to present a valid CIF-SS media credential will result in media access being denied.
- All media members must have media access passes clearly displayed while on the sideline, on the field, or in the press box. Failure to have visible credentials can result in being removed from the sideline, field, or press box.
- During the games, the JSerra Athletic Administration requests that media members (photographers, videographers, reporters) do not walk through the JSerra Football team sideline. This is to ensure that our players and coaches have a proper and safe playing and coaching environment. Failure to adhere to this policy will result in field, sideline, and press box access being revoked at the discretion of the JSerra Athletic Administration.
- Coverage of JSerra Athletic contests is done solely at the risk of approved and credentialed media members. JSerra Catholic High School assumes no responsibility for injuries sustained while covering athletic contests.

JSerra Athletics Media Access Policy for Non-Football Games

- All media access requests will be reviewed upon being received. Submission of a media access request does not guarantee approval for media access.
- All media access requests will be approved or denied by the Sports Information Director via phone call or email.
- Upon entry to the stadium, field, court, or gymnasium, you must possess a valid CIF-SS media credential. Failure to present a valid CIF-SS media credential will result in media access being denied.
- Coverage of JSerra Athletic contests is done solely at the risk of approved and credentialed media members. JSerra Catholic High School assumes no responsibility for injuries sustained while covering athletic contests.
