Eligibility impacts participation

Eligibility

Grades/Citizenship (AR 6145)

- 2.0 GPA, earned passing grades in minimum of 4 classes during the last applicable grading period
- Cannot have 2 or more "unsatisfactory" citizenship grades during last applicable grading period
- No probation period for incoming 9th grade students

Elgibility Cont.

Attendance (AR 6145)

- Attend full day on the day of participation OR
- Attend all classes leading up to the activity if during the day
- ***Exceptions: Written documentation of medical appointment, court appearance, or reason for which site principal deems appropriate

Discipline

- Suspended students are ineligible for a period of 2 weeks beyond the duration of the suspension

Attendance Matters

- Attend all scheduled classes on game days
- Remain in class until official dismissal
- No leaving campus early without approval
- Excessive tardies may impact participation

Attendance (AR 6145)

- Attend full day on the day of participation **OR**
- Attend all classes leading up to the activity if during the day
- ***Exceptions: Written documentation of medical appointment, court appearance, or reason for which site principal deems appropriate

Chain of Communication



- To address concerns professionally:
- Step 1
Student-Athlete → Assistant Coach/Lead Coach
- Step 2
Parent → Assistant Coach/Lead Coach
- Step 3
Parent → Head Coach
- Step 4
Parent → Assistant Principal of Athletics & Facilities
- Following the chain allows concerns to be resolved at the appropriate level.

24-hour rule

- Please observe a mandatory 24-hour cool-off period before discussing:
 - Playing time
 - Coaching strategy
 - Officiating
 - Game outcomes
- Please allow 24-48 business hours for responses.
- Do not approach coaches immediately after contests.

Appropriate Topics

- Appropriate Topics:
 - Academic progress
 - Team expectations
 - Communication concerns
 - Safety concerns
- Not Appropriate:
 - Playing time demands
 - Comparing athletes
 - Coaching decisions
 - Strategy or play calling

Athletic Safety

- Kim Hansen – Athletic Trainer
- Report all injuries immediately to:
 - Athletic Trainer
 - Coach
 - Athletics Office
- Student-athletes must maintain:
 - Athletic clearance
 - Insurance information

Concussion & Heat Safety

- Concussion Protocol
- Any athlete suspected of sustaining a concussion:
 - Will be removed from participation
 - Will not return until properly cleared
- Heat & Weather Safety
- Don Lugo follows CIF Southern Section heat safety and WBGT guidelines.
- Safety is always our first priority.

Transportation

- All students and parents must fill out form 1465 and have it on file with the Athletic Department.
- If you are traveling with a different parent you will need to fill out form 680 and provide insurance, DMV record and other parent signature.

Students transported for school activities in privately owned vehicles fall into two categories:
Students transported solely by their parents or guardians.

All operators of motor vehicles in California are required to maintain Automotive Liability Insurance at legal minimum dollar amounts or more. It is assumed that any parent transporting their child(ren) will have such coverage, and they will have a valid and current driver's license, issued by the State of California. In this instance, these parents/guardians will not be required to furnish proof of driver's license and insurance, or a DMV 6-Month Driving Record to the District.

Your signature at the bottom of this document is your acknowledgement you have read this document and agree to maintain a valid and current driver's license, as well as remain insured to the legal minimum amount required by law.

Transfer Eligibility Reminder

- Transfer students must see AP Athletics
- CIF approval may be required
- Participation is subject to CIF eligibility rules
- Student/Athletes can be determined ineligible and games forfeited if the transfer is not put into CIF.
