



Pasadena High School Winter Sports Update

Pasadena High School winter athletics continue to showcase resilience, excellence, and Bulldog pride as programs move toward the close of the regular season.

The Boys Basketball program celebrated a milestone this winter as head coach Anthony Brooks recorded his 250th career win at Pasadena High School, becoming just the second coach in program history to reach that mark.

Girls Water Polo continues to play at a high level and is currently ranked in the top half of teams in the CIF Southern Section. Boys Soccer, Girls Soccer, and Boys Basketball also competed and played well in tournaments over winter break, gaining valuable experience against strong competition.

This winter season also serves as a time of reflection following the Eaton Fire on January 7, 2025. The fire significantly impacted the Pasadena community, forcing school and athletic shutdowns and creating challenges upon return, including securing practice space and game locations while supporting players and coaches displaced by the fire. Despite these obstacles, the Boys and Girls Soccer and Basketball programs persevered and still earned CIF playoff berths last season.

With less than a month remaining in the winter regular season, Pasadena High School looks forward to a strong finish and the opportunity to see multiple Bulldog programs once again qualify for the CIF playoffs.
